#### **2-1-1 Advisory Committee Meeting**

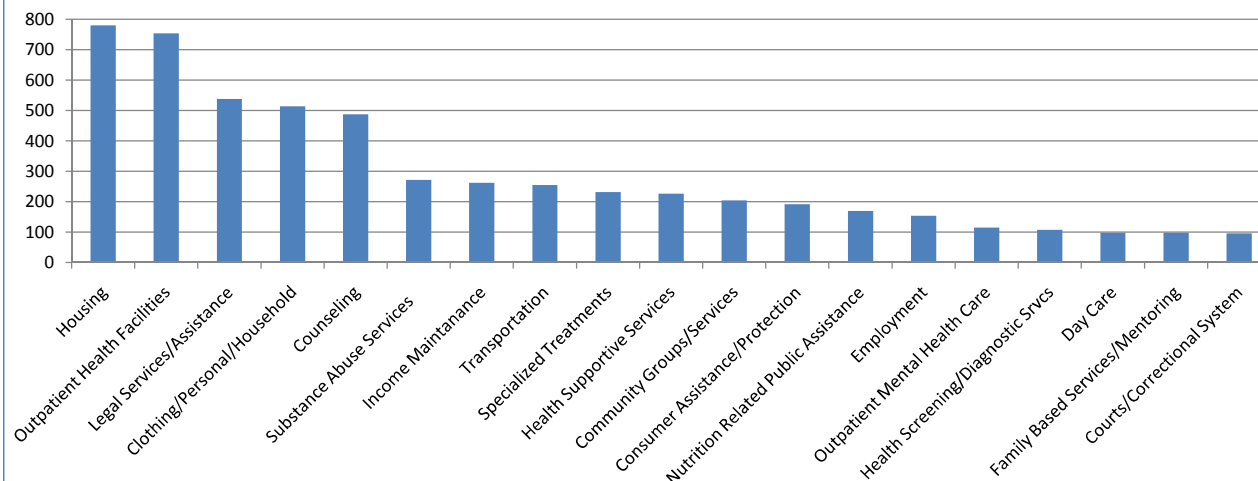
The next meeting of the 2-1-1 Advisory Committee will be held at 9:00am at the 2-1-1 Call Center on May 26 and normally occurs regularly on the 4th Thursday of every other month.

### Beyond Basic Emergency Needs

We've examined the details of basic emergency needs many times in the past so it seems appropriate to take a look at the most important of the other 52% of needs expressed by 2-1-1 callers. The needs that will be ignored for the time being are Utilities, Rent Payment Assistance, Information Services (The caller already knows what he/she wants i.e. "What's the number for the TAD office in Ontario?"), Food/Meals, and Shelter/Motel Vouchers.

We also removed Computer Educational Supportive Services for the moment because they would skew the numbers. I'll say more about that in the next section of this report.

### Beyond Basic Needs Count: January - March 2011



People looking for affordable or section 8 housing is not surprisingly at the top of this list, since this need is a precursor to shelter/motel vouchers and rent or utility payment assistance for the many who have had an income producer laid off or had hours reduced, creating financial hardship.

Health access is a growing issue, but perhaps somewhat obscured by the more fundamental and dominating housing and food problems. This is followed by legal services, a high percentage of which are for eviction issues.

Clothing, Personal and Household Goods is an area where more resources are needed. There are many places to get clothing, but the need is usually for business clothing, as for job interviews. Refrigerators and beds are requested regularly, but there are few sources for them, especially if the consumer is an adult.

### Computer Educational Supportive Services - Crossing the Digital Divide

The digital Divide is alive and well in San Bernardino County, directly impacting the health and wealth of our communities downward, and negatively impacting business growth. First, a quick look at the digital scene.

71% of the Inland Empire is on Broadband currently, according to the Californian and Information Technology Annual Survey, 2010 Public Policy Institute of California in partnership with CETF and Zero Divide.

This 79% is a significant increase from 2008 but it still means that 609,000 San Bernardino County residents are not connected by broadband to the internet. And for low income and Latinos, it's only 1 out of every 3 who are connected.

The disadvantages of not being connected to the internet by broadband and for digital illiteracy in general are overwhelming. Consider all today that requires competent high-speed internet access: applying for Social Security benefits, filing Tax Returns, Department of Motor Vehicles such as paying tickets, vehicle registration and drivers license renewal (Usage of the DMV website to conduct these activities increased 12% during 2010.), applying for a job, accessing health information, conducting a job search, smart shopping, parent-teacher communication, online courses, tele-health applications, to name a few.

California Emerging Technology Fund is providing leadership throughout the state of California to help bridge the digital gap. An introductory meeting was held in February where 2-1-1, librarians, Family Resource Center staff and many others attended to discuss how to move forward. There are tools available.

Clicking on the box will take you to a page where you can input a zip code or city and find resources in the four major areas: Computer Training, Access to Computers, Community Events, and Internet Hotspots.

The digital divide will only be bridged as those of us who interact with the dis-connected communities deliberately make helping them become digitally literate and connected part of our business model. Come to the meeting and find out how you can get a toolkit to help you incorporate the "Get Connected" tools into your processes. This is virtually a no-cost way to better serve our consumers, and build stronger communities at the same time.

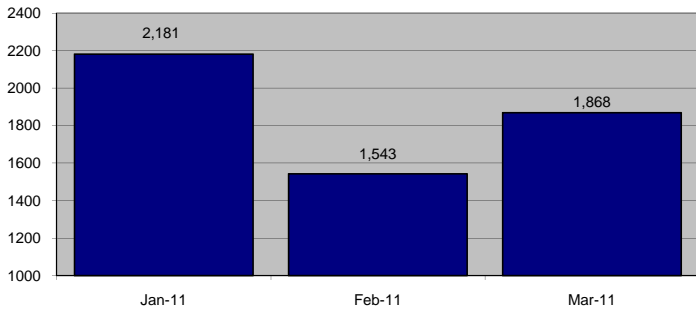

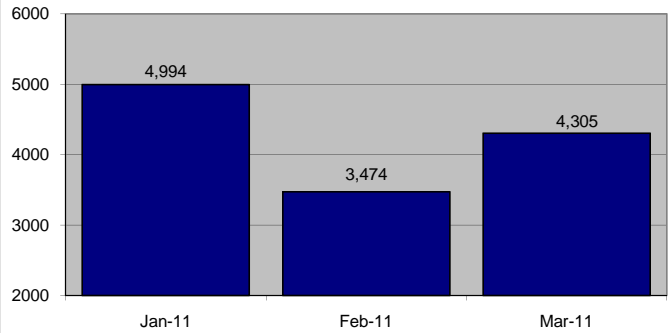
