2-1-1 News Items

2-1-1 Advisory Committee Meeting

The next meeting of the 2-1-1 Advisory Council will be held at 9:00am at the 2-1-1 Call Center on July 28 and normally occurs regularly on the 4th Thursday of every other month.

The Advisory Council has moved to create a 211 Strategic Plan. See below for more details. Your input is important.

First a word from our callers...

"This service is fantastic! I can't believe it's free. Thank you!"

These are the words of a recent caller, experiencing for the first time this tool called 2-1-1, and amazing blend of technology and people power. Currently, about 20,000 individuals and families dial 2-1-1 for the first time in San Bernardino County every year.

It is built. Will you come? -- 211 Strategic Planning

The usual report information is contained in the following pages, but this front page space will be used this time for a short discussion about the future of your 2-1-1, the features of which are easily listed:

- 3-digit phone number
- 24 hour accessibility
- comprehensive, searchable database, accessible to the public at 211sb.org
- 2 staff dedicated to continuous database maintenance
- national standards (AIRS – Alliance of Information & Referral Systems - airs.org)
- highly trained, professional, bilingual staff
- 150 languages available through contracted interpreter service
- 2-1-1 caller data collection

The benefits of having a 2-1-1 system are also broad:

- residents are quickly and easily connected to community resources
- 24 hour accessibility means that 2-1-1 acts on behalf of hundreds of other agencies when their offices are closed
- public safety is enhanced during disaster as 2-1-1 relieves inappropriate calls from 9-1-1
- taxpayers save money from the consolidation of hotlines, decreasing duplication of services
- local governments benefit from increased efficiencies
- primary data from 2-1-1 callers available for needs assessment and grant writing
- nonprofits more able to focus on clients, less on screening

2-1-1 in San Bernardino County is not yet 5 years old, currently answers only about 67,000 calls per year (about 3% penetration rate), and has a limited public awareness. A fully mature 2-1-1 has a penetration rate of 10% or more (200,000+ calls for San Bernardino County), and performs many functions that serve to support the public, local governments, and nonprofits.

As 211 San Bernardino County evolves, it is essential that the shape of that evolution be determined by the community it serves. Your voice, your thoughts, your needs and wants...your vision is important to this process.

Please be looking for survey and focus group invitations, and lend your intelligence to the upcoming process for creating a strategic plan for 211 San Bernardino County.

Thanks to the 211 Advisory Council, the County Board of Supervisors and countless County Departments and staff, the First 5 Commission and staff, and all of the nonprofit Execs and staff who make 2-1-1 possible and vibrant.

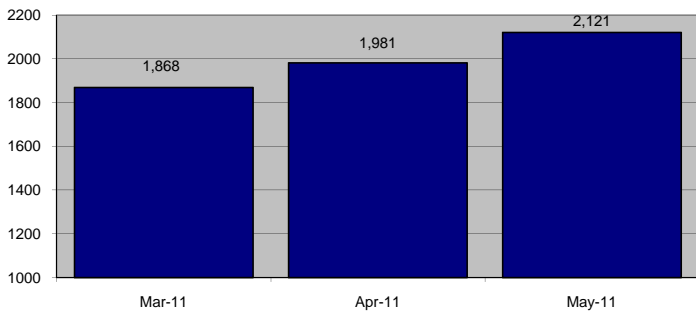

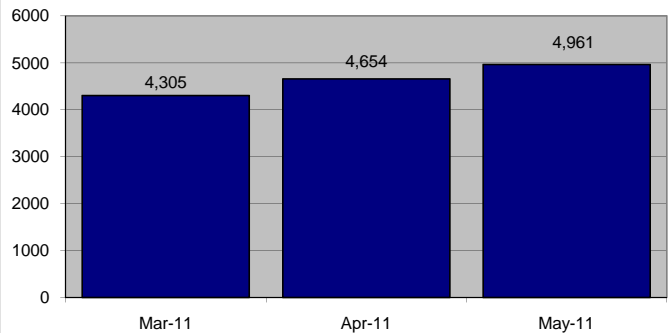

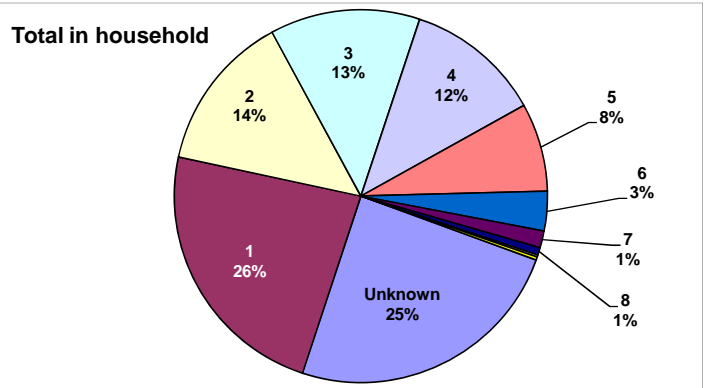
Total number of children under 6

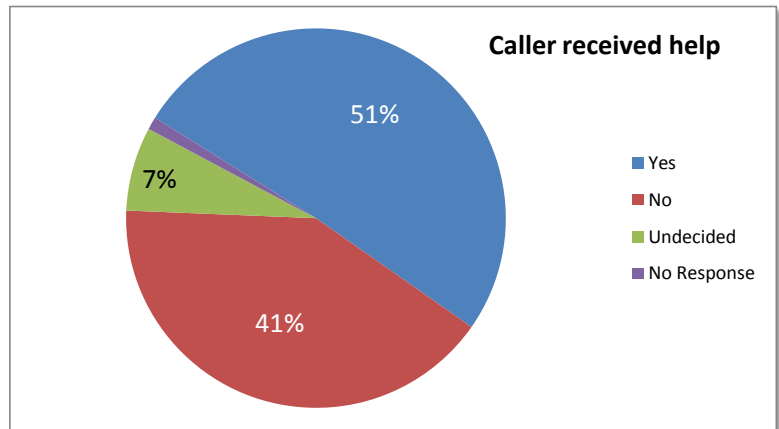
