# San Bernardino County Major Regions Environmental Quality Needs: Total Number Needs Identified



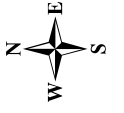
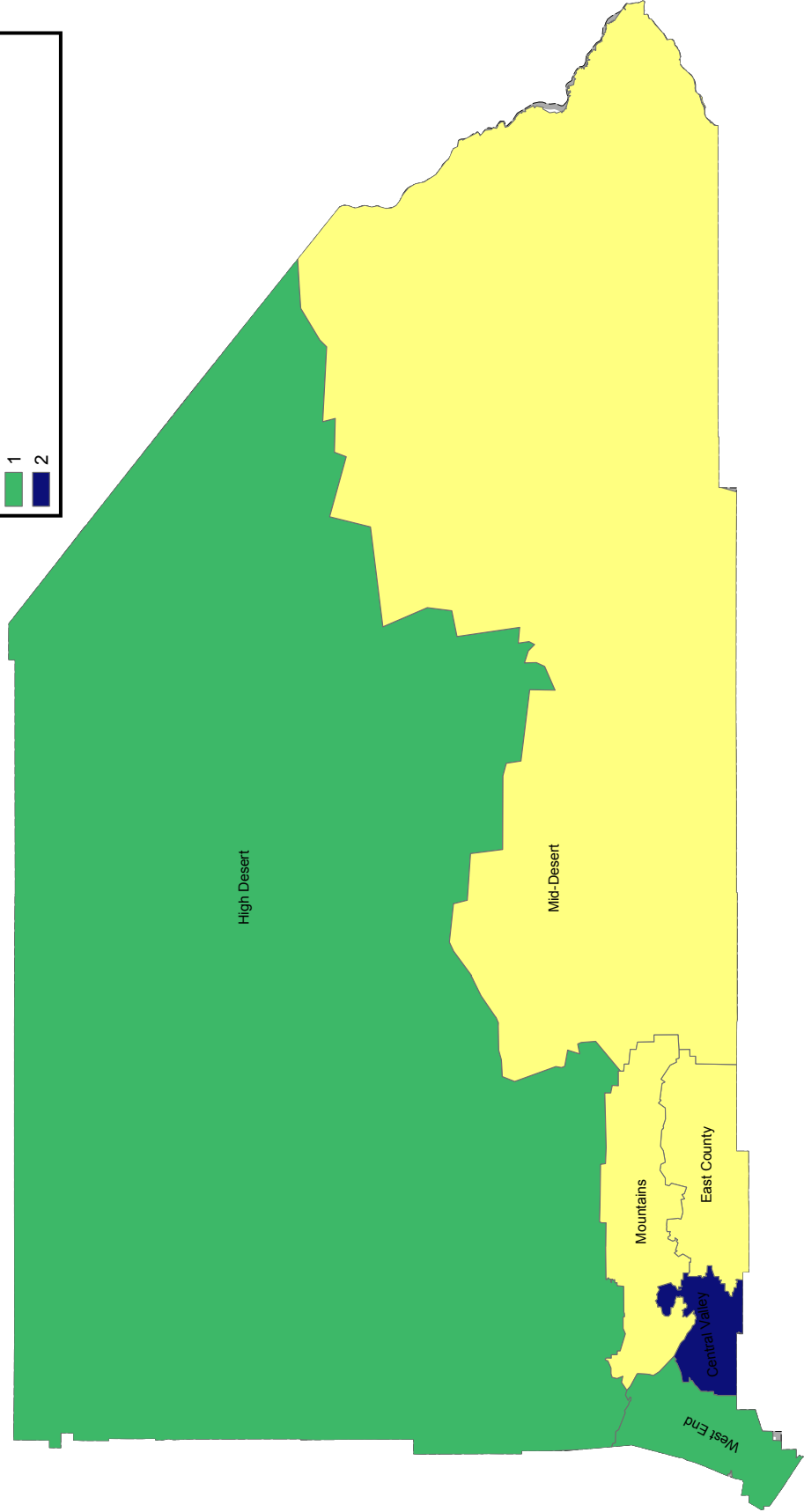
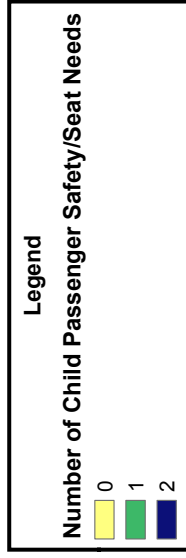

# San Bernardino County Major Regions Environmental Quality Needs: Number of Animal Services Needs Identified



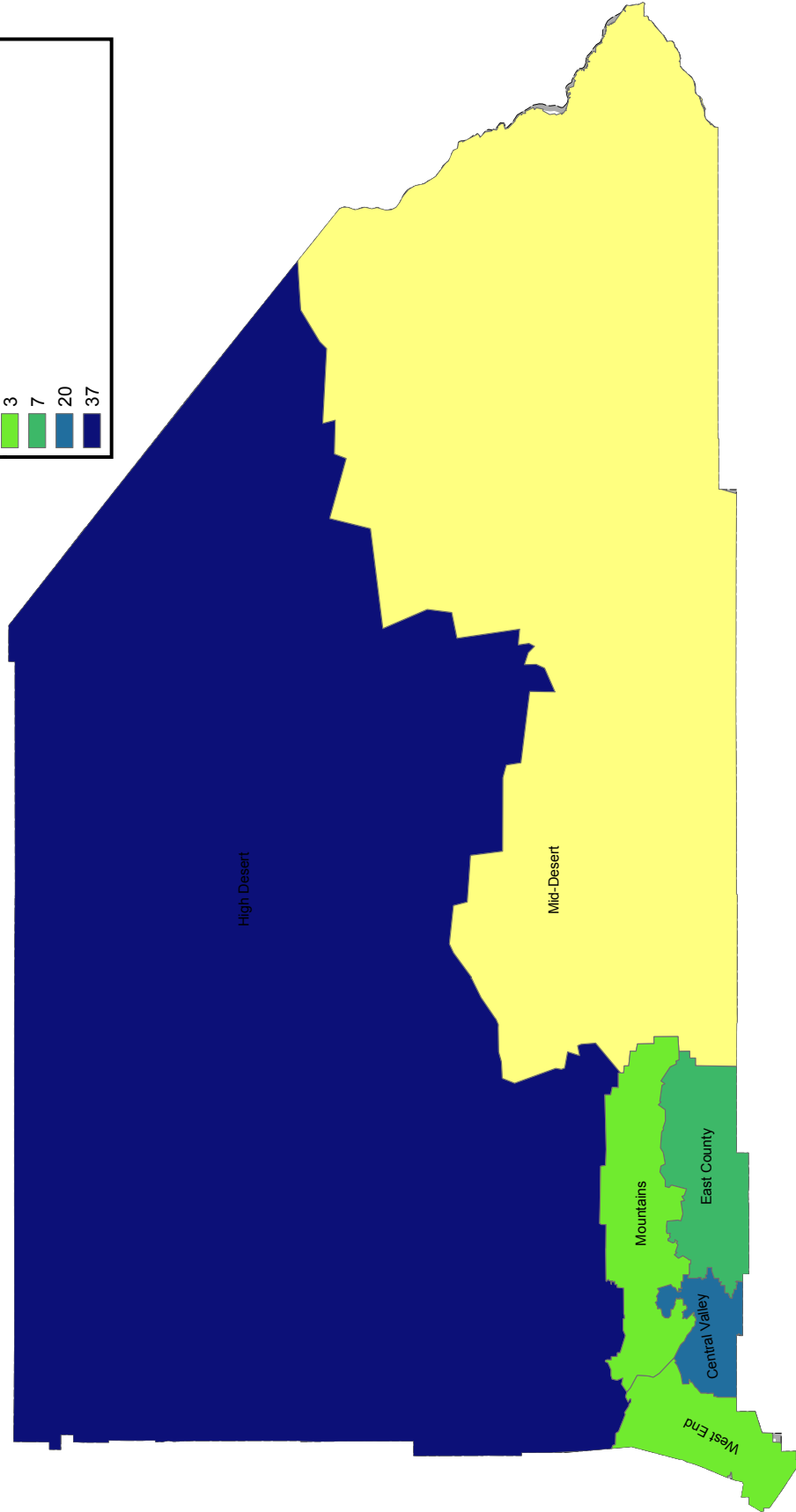
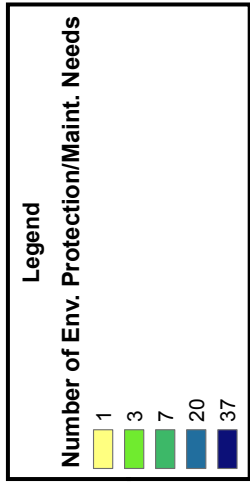

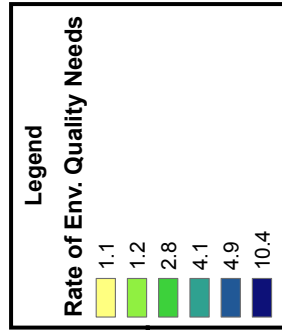
# San Bernardino County Major Regions Environmental Quality Needs: Number of Environmental Protection/Maintenance Needs Identified

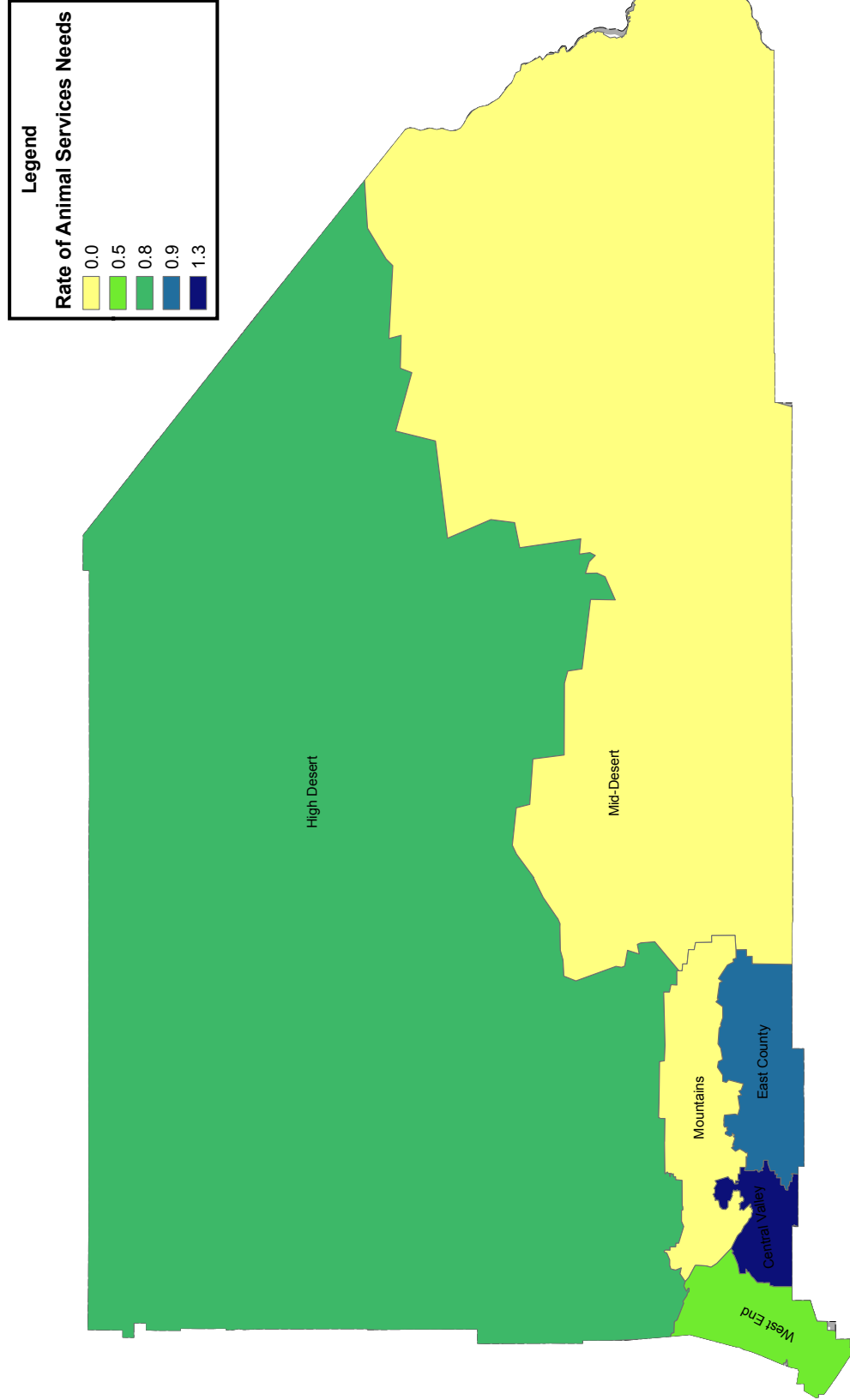

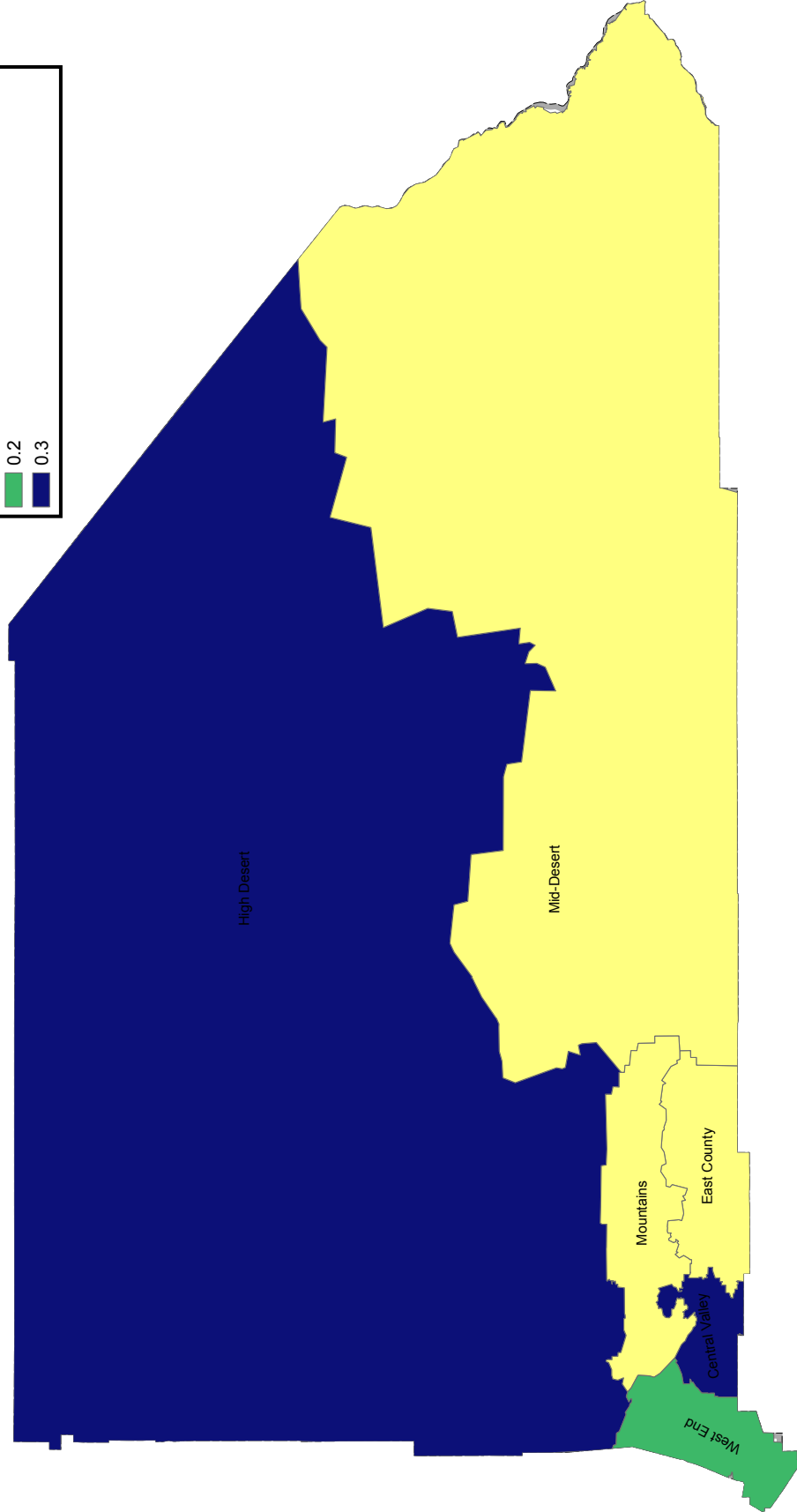
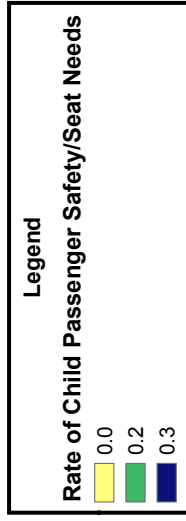
# San Bernardino County Major Regions Environmental Quality Needs: Rate of Animal Services Needs Identified Per 100,000 Pop.

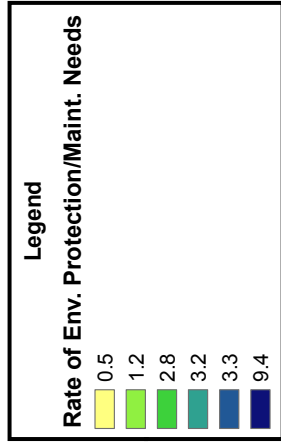

# San Bernardino County Major Regions Environmental Quality Needs: Rate of Environmental Protection/Maintenance Needs Identified Per 100,000 Pop.

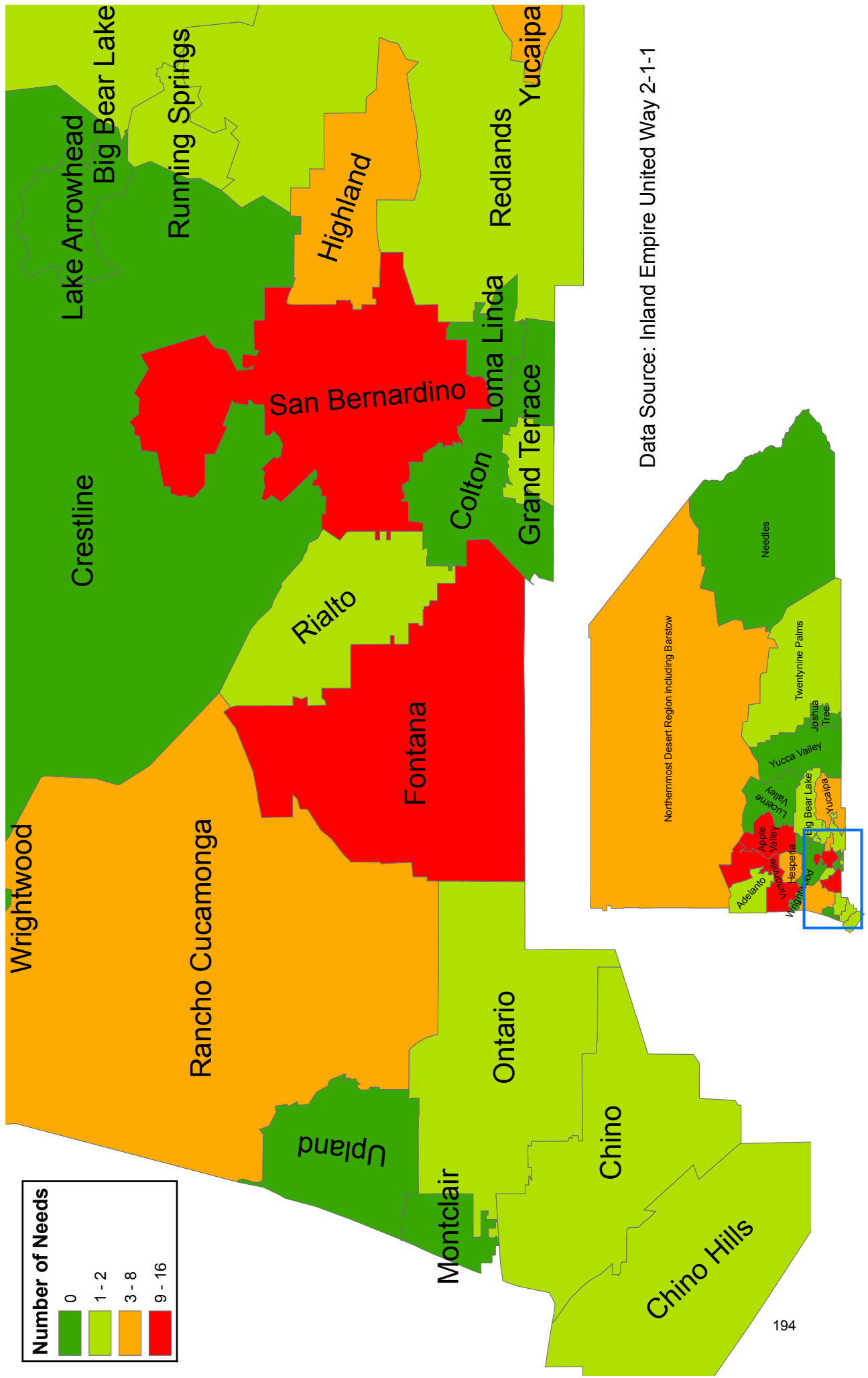

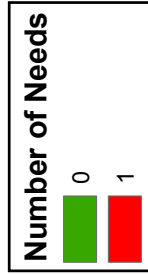
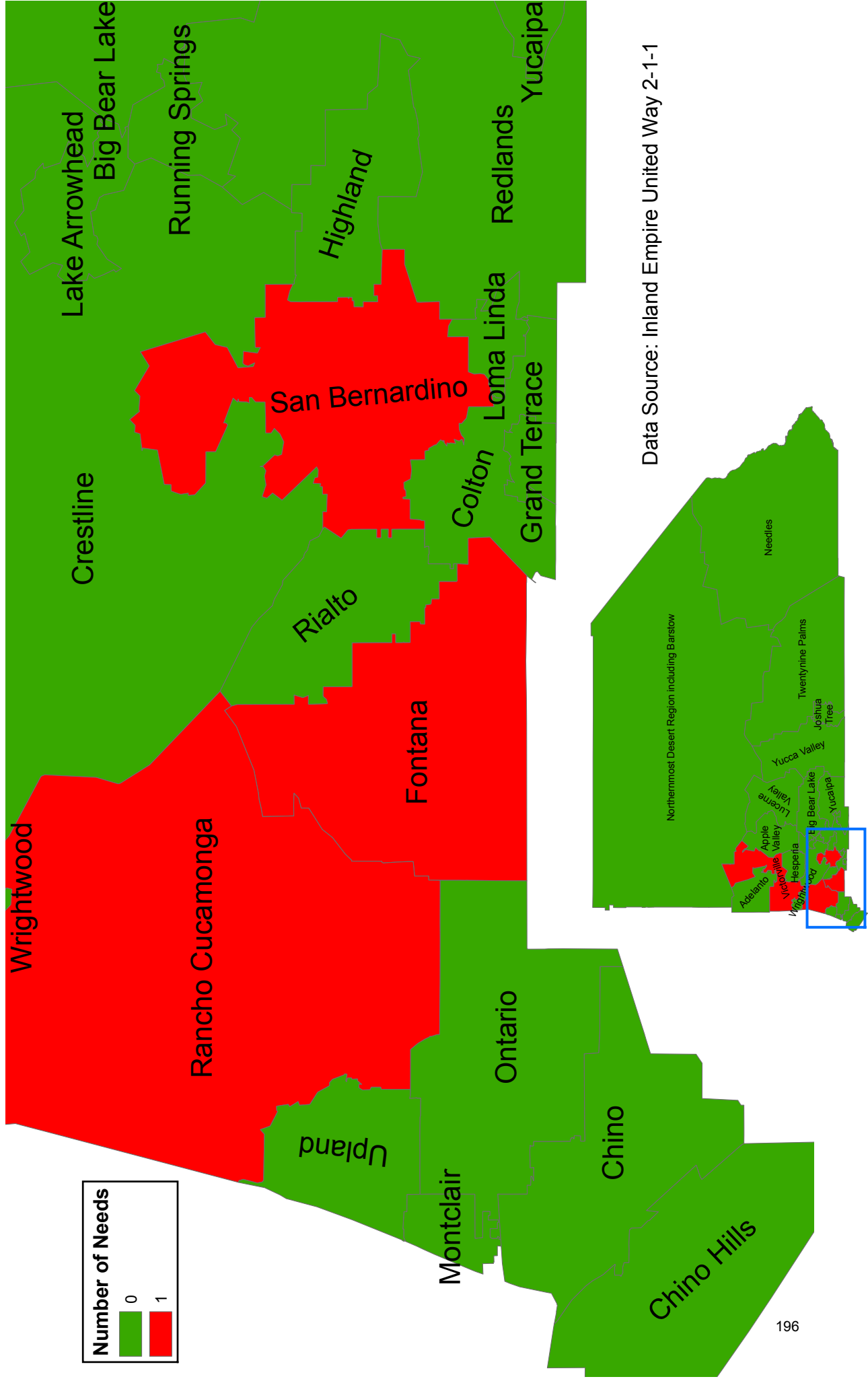
# San Bernardino County Communities Environmental Quality: Number of Animal Services Needs Identified

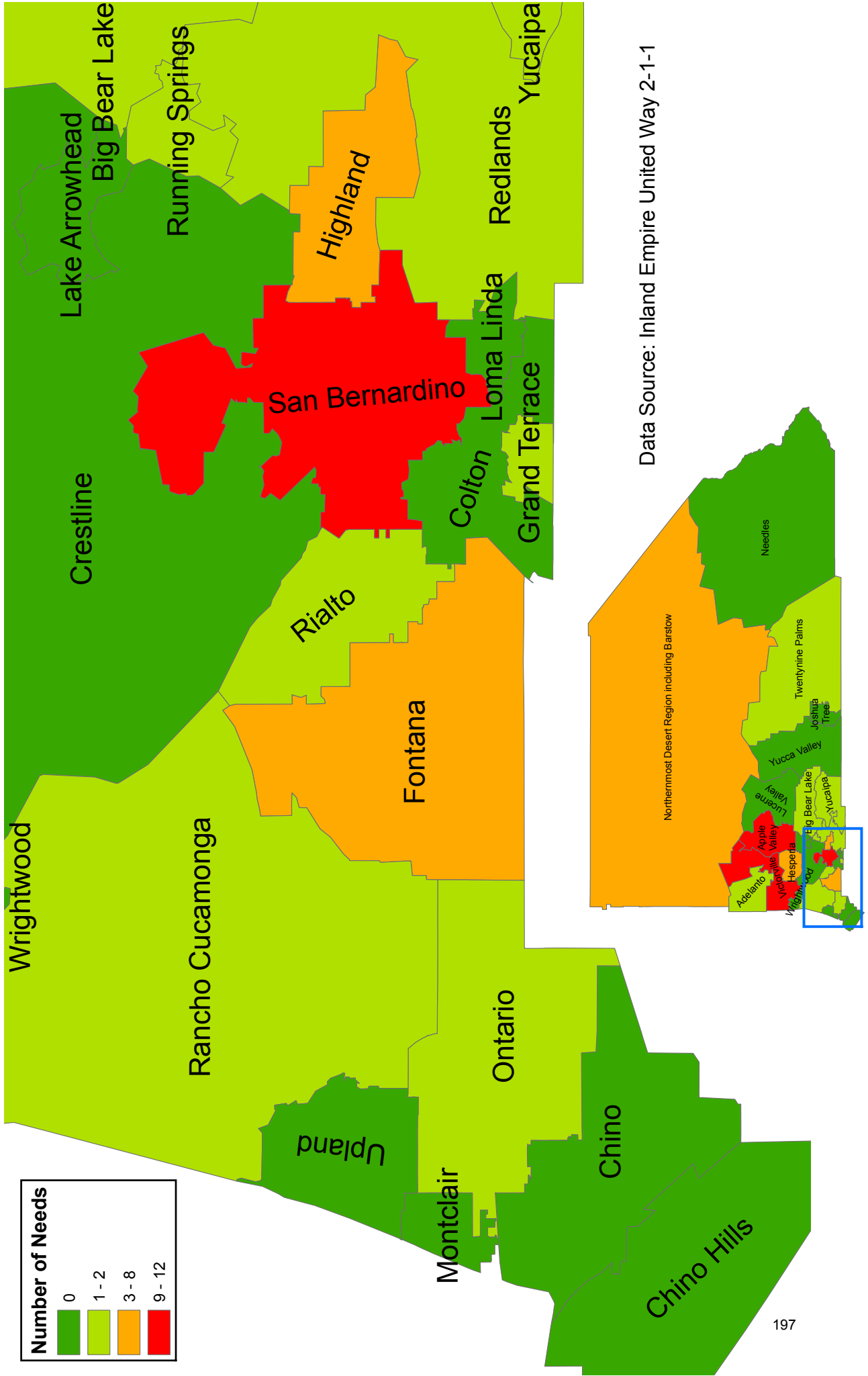
## Environmental Quality: Number of Child Passenger Safety/Seats Needs Identified

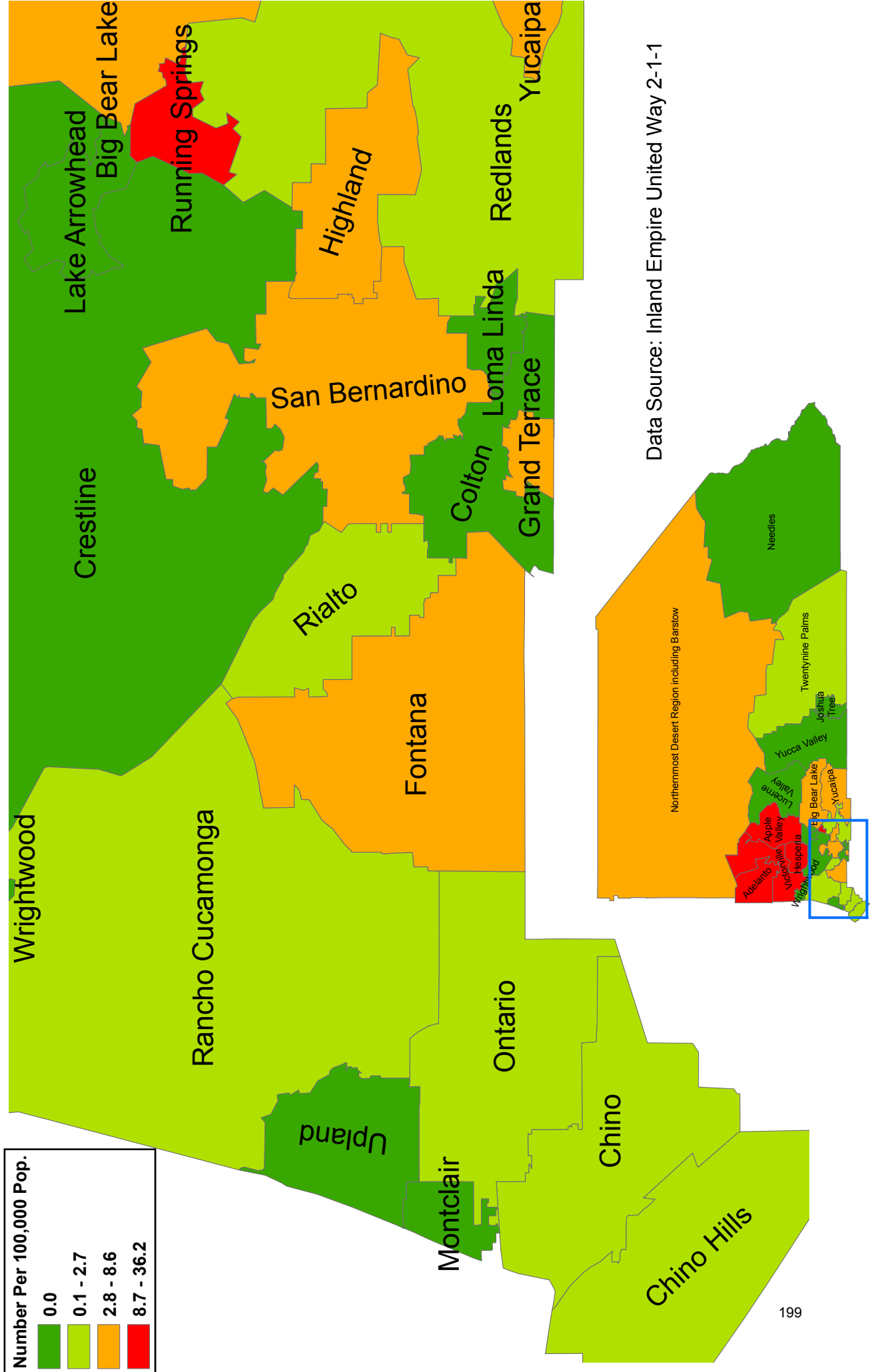

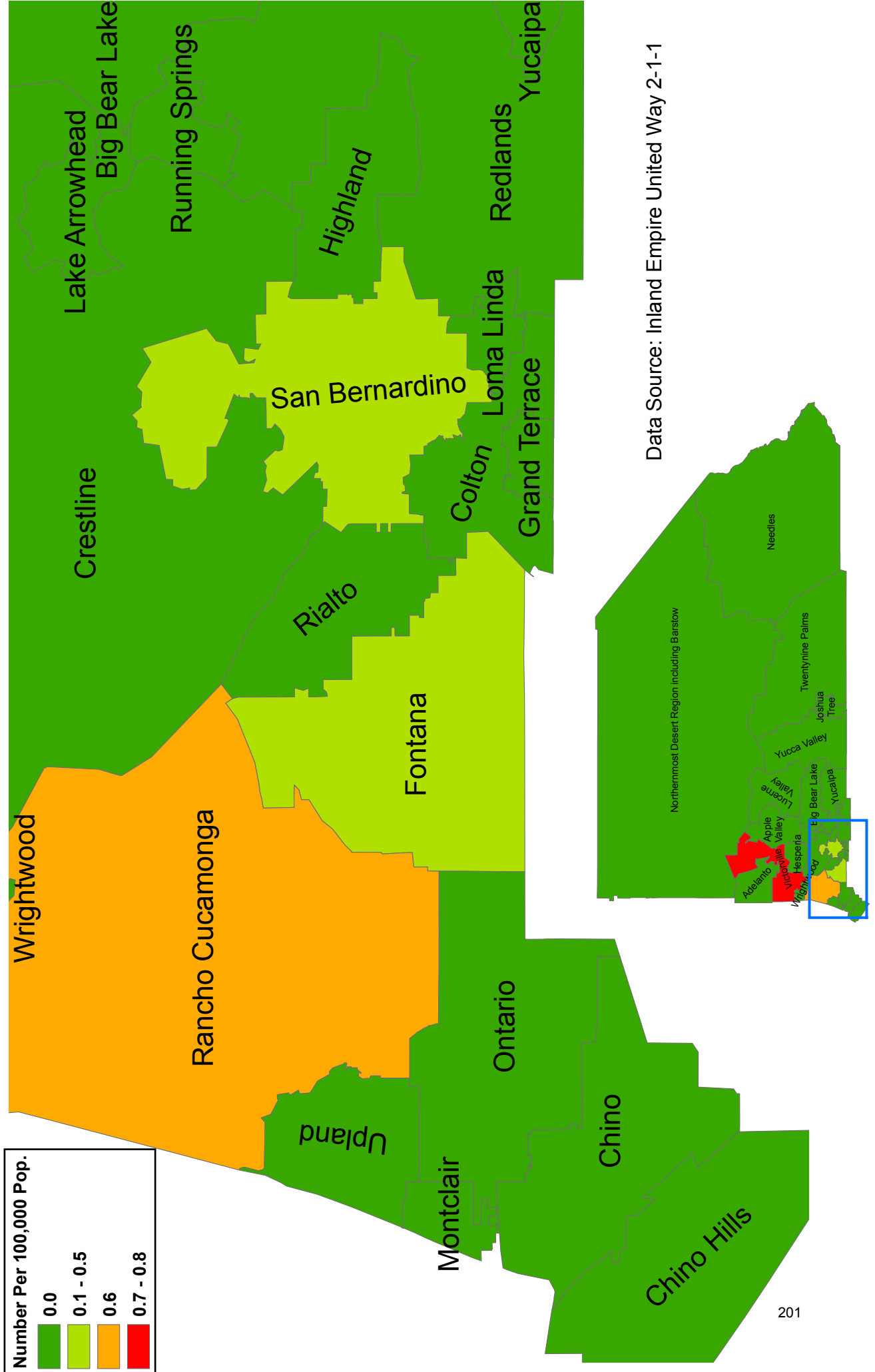
