- » \$2 a week can provide 90 callers with comprehensive referrals from nationally certified call specialists
- » \$4 a week can connect 180 kids to the resources they need, making a difference in their lives
- » \$10 a week can provide training and equipment for one member of the 2-1-1 disaster response team
- » \$15 a week can equal to 200 more people learning about 2-1-1 for the first time

- » \$5 a week can paint a mural on a local school wall to educate and brighten a child's day
- » \$15 a week can plant a garden to beautify the school grounds and invigorate the science curriculum
- » \$20 a week can provide books and materials for a volunteer-led Saturday reading program at a local school

- » \$5 a week can provide a homeless or very low-income child with Kids Pack services for one year
- » \$10 a week can allow a classroom to participate in the School Tools program for one year

- » **Project Leader Training** prepares interested individuals to assume a more active role in their community by leading volunteer activities
- » **Corporate Volunteering** provides opportunities for corporations to create team-building volunteer opportunities for employee groups
- » **Youth Volunteering** empowers youth to serve through age appropriate opportunities that are relevant to their interest
- » **Special Events** give community volunteers a chance to interact with each other through team-based opportunities, volunteer recognition parties and theme-based projects covering topics focused on the environment, health, and homelessness and hunger

IEUW KIDSMART

PROVIDING DISADVANTAGED CHILDREN WITH THE RESOURCES THEY NEED TO LEARN AND SUCCEED IN SCHOOL BY REMOVING BARRIERS TO SUCCESS

- » **Kids Pack** provides nutritious food to homeless and very low-income children over the weekend, when school meals are not available
- » **School Tools** provides new, free school supplies for low-income children and classrooms through the Teacher Resource Center (TRC) and special distributions
- » **Healthy Kids** encourages physical fitness and good nutrition for kids through activities, special events and community partnerships



IEUW PATHWAYS

STRENGTHENING OPPORTUNITIES IN THE COMMUNITY THAT ENCOURAGE GREATER FINANCIAL STABILITY FOR LOW-INCOME FAMILIES AND INDIVIDUALS

- » **Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) & Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC)** offers FREE tax clinics staffed by trained college-student volunteers to assist qualified low-income wage earners with their basic tax return preparation and filing
- » **Community Voice Mail (CVM)** provides low-income families and individuals with access to telephone voicemail service to encourage job attainment and stable housing
