- Meet other basic needs
- Strengthen after-school programs to facilitate social and academic development
- Support physical and mental health programs for underserved youth
- Engage the community and mobilize resources to create a positive change for kids

Programs include:

- **Kids Pack** - Weekend backpacks of nutritious food for homeless and very low-income school children
- **School Tools** - Free school supplies for low-income children
- **Healthy Kids** - Encouraging physical fitness and good nutrition for kids through activities and special events

FINANCIAL STABILITY: TRANSITIONING FAMILIES FROM POVERTY TO STABILITY.

Inland Empire United Way and its community impact partners provide programs in our community to:

- Increase uptake of available income supplements to low-income families and individuals
- Reduce/Eliminate barriers to employment for low-income families and individuals
- Alleviate food and shelter insecurity

Programs include:

- **Community Voice Mail (CVM)** - Access to telephone voicemail service to encourage job attainment and stable housing for low-income families and individuals
- **Volunteer Income Tax Assistance/Earned Income Tax Credit (VITA/EITC)** - Tax clinics staffed by trained college-student volunteers that assist income qualified individuals with basic tax preparation at no charge
