

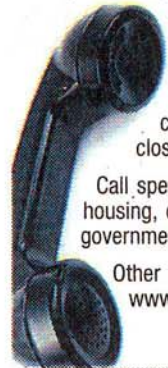

SAN BERNARDINO — The toll-free 2-1-1 phone number provides information and referrals for health and social services and the latest information on the San Bernardino County fires.

Dialing 2-1-1 is the quickest way to access non-emergency resources.

Residents can donate cash to the San Bernardino County Fire Recovery Fund (Inland Empire United Way) to ensure that families and individuals most-affected by the Slide and Grass Valley Fires will receive assistance needed to continue their lives.



Residents are encouraged to dial 2-1-1 or (888) 435-7565 for information on current fire emergencies such as road closings, evacuation shelters, mail/postal information, school closings and free storage.

Call specialists can also give callers information on shelter and housing, clothing, food and water, animal assistance, health care and government resources among other information.
